

### **April BPC/V-S Silhouette Match**

Nineteen shooters were treated to perfect conditions at the April BPC/V/S monthly match—high 80's, only a little teasing wind to keep things interesting, and strong young target setters. The Overall Match Winners were Chip Mate with a score of 30, followed by his partner, Steve Rhoades with a 28 and Sherman Brownlee with a 26. Patric Taylor took High Master with Rich Grey picking up a AAA win and Paul Barrow taking first AA. Newcomer Jason Hook, shooting Vintage Sniper rifle smoked the competition, delivering a score of 34 with 10 rams, 10 turkeys and 5 chickens. What? He missed a pig? Nori Thorne, in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, needs to keep the squeals of joy to a minimum when hitting a chicken to avoid range alibis from other shooters. Tim Thorne took 3<sup>rd</sup> place V/S.

Eight Vintage Sniper Rifles filled out the ranks—enough to make the match director add V/S classifications. Beginning with the May match, V/S shooters may use High Power individual classifications found in the NRA Rulebook. In May there will be Overall Winners, Master, AAA, A and A/B class awards as we currently have in Iron Sight and Scope.

The match director noticed that several super senior shooters were unable to complete the course of fire because of off-hand chickens. Beginning with the May shoot, super seniors may opt to shoot a different BPC rifle at offhand chickens ONLY, and ONLY in the monthly matches—not state championships.

The next monthly match will be May 20, the third Saturday in May.
